**Secondary Cancer**      New tumours, or metastases, which are formed because cancer cells from the original tumour have broken off and moved to other parts of the body

**Primary Cancer**      The first malignant tumour to develop in a particular part of the body

**Primary Care**      services delivered in the community, based in GP surgeries

**Secondary Care**      services are local hospital services

**Tertiary Care**      services are specialised centres for the treatment of specific conditions

**Stratified Pathways/Open Access Follower up**      Self-management pathway, moving away from traditional clinical follow-up, dependant on individual patient risk factors
