

HOW TO SET UP TEST PATIENTS IN ARIA FOR REGIMEN VALIDATION

As part of the regimen validation process, two test patients should be set-up for each regimen to be tested, one for the pharmacist validation and one for clinician validation which is then used for the nurse validation.

PHARMACIST TEST PATIENT – ADULT REGIMENS	
1.	<u>Demographics Window – General Tab</u> Patient name: use K&M SACT protocol number, e.g. BRA-002, as follows: Last name (upper case): XXBRA First name: 002 D.O.B.: enter any date but ensure patient will be over 18 years Error/test patient: radio button must be checked
2.	<u>Demographics Window – IDs Tab:</u> R number: BRA-002, BRA-002v2, BRA-002v3 etc. (i.e. appropriate K&M SACT protocol number)
3.	<u>History Window</u> Allergies Tab: Check 'No Known Allergies' Medications Tab: Check 'No External Medications'
4.	<u>Vital Signs Window:</u> Large patient – Height 190cm; Weight 115kg

CONSULTANT TEST PATIENT – ADULT REGIMENS	
1.	<u>Demographics Window – General Tab</u> Patient name: use K&M SACT protocol number, e.g. BRA-002, as follows: Last name (upper case): XXTEST002 First name: BRA D.O.B.: enter any date but ensure patient will be over 18 years Error/test patient: radio button must be checked
2.	<u>Demographics Window – IDs Tab:</u> R number: BRA002, BRA002v2, BRA002v3 etc. (i.e. appropriate K&M SACT protocol number)
3.	<u>History Window</u> Allergies Tab: Check 'No Known Allergies' Medications Tab: Check 'No External Medications'
4.	<u>Vital Signs Window:</u> Large patient – Height 190cm; Weight 115kg

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PHARMACIST TEST PATIENT – PAEDIATRIC REGIMENS	
1.	<u>Demographics Window – General Tab</u> Patient name: use K&M SACT protocol number, e.g. BRA-002, as follows: Last name (upper case): XXBRA First name: 002 D.O.B.: enter any date but ensure patient will be under 18 years Error/test patient: radio button must be checked
2.	<u>Demographics Window – IDs Tab:</u> R number: BRA-002 BRA-002v2, BRA-002v3 etc. (i.e. appropriate K&M SACT protocol number)
3.	<u>History Window</u> Allergies Tab: Check 'No Known Allergies' Medications Tab: Check 'No External Medications'
4.	<u>Vital Signs Window:</u> Large patient – Height 150cm; Weight 50kg
