

# I may have cancer. What happens now?

DAY  
1

Your GP refers you to hospital for tests. These will be done within two weeks.



DAY  
10

The hospital will phone you to make an appointment if your GP hasn't made one for you.



Ring the hospital if they have not phoned you after 10 days.

DAY  
14

Make your appointment for as soon as you can. It's really important that you go as soon as possible.

DAY  
28

You do not have cancer. Contact your GP again if you still feel unwell.

Cancer diagnosed and treatment options discussed.

By day 28 you will have been for your tests and have your results.



When the hospital phones you it may not show a number.

- Have a pen and paper ready.
- Have questions prepared.
